Camp Harlow Overnight Camp Information

Drop-Off

Camper drop off starts at 8:30am the first morning of camp. You will jump in line up front to get checked in and get your cabin number. There will be camp nurses there as well for any health related questions and to drop off medications. Do not pack medications and prescriptions in camper's luggage as you will be handing that off to the nurses when you drop off.

You may then walk with your camper to their cabin to meet their counselors and get them settled.

Pick-Up

Camper pick-up is at 3:30pm the last day of camp. We do a Parent Connection Meeting at 3:15pm in the lodge that we would love for you to be at! Come and find out what your camper experienced during their time at camp! Please do not arrive before 3pm! Entry to the lodge will begin at 3:05pm! Meeting to start at 3:15pm. Parents will be released to the check-out areas at 3:30pm. Check-Out areas will be at Boys Cabins, Girls Cabins, and Wagon Area. You will get in line at the table with the computers and check your camper out with staff. Please make sure to have your PICTURE ID, as you will not be able to pick up without it.

Details

During camp, parents are not allowed to enter the campgrounds past the Kiosk. If you need to pick-up your child for an appointment, you will stop at the Kiosk and staff will locate your camper and bring them up. This takes time, so be prepared to wait. We prefer for the least amount of interruptions during their time at camp, so if you can reschedule appointments and arrange for missed practices, that would be ideal! We try to operate camp like we aren't in the middle of town :)

Packing List

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Clothes for five days (including long pants, closed-toed shoes, & sweatshirt)
- Toothbrush, soap, deodorant, bath/swim towel, etc.
- Modest swimsuit (no bikinis)
- Sunscreen, Hat
- Water bottle to keep hydrated, water stations are around camp to refill water bottles
- Insect repellent
- Medications: Must be in original packaging. Place in a plastic zipper bag labeled with name.

* Label items with the camper's name and be sure to check the lost and found table at pick-up.

What NOT to bring

- Cell Phones, Electronics, bluetooth speakers
- Weapons, knives
- Valuables
- Jewelry
- Bikini Swimsuits, short shorts, low-cut tops

Camp Store

- **Money:** We have a Camp Store & Cafe where campers can purchase drinks, treats, slushies, snacks, toys, apparel and more! This is optional, but a super fun addition for campers. You can add money to your campers store account by logging into your parent account online. You will also be able to check their balance and add more funds as needed. The Camp Store & Cafe do not take cash payments, so make sure funds are added to their account prior to arriving.
- **Apparel Credit:** Each camper gets a \$12 Apparel Credit to use towards a t-shirt, sweatshirt or hat! Cannot be applied to items less than \$12. 1 Apparel credit per camper, per camp.
- **Unused Funds:** If there is \$5 or less in your campers account after camp ends, it will be automatically donated to the scholarship fund. If there is \$5.01 or more remaining in your campers account after camp ends, it will be refunded to you within 4 weeks.

Camp Mail

- Everybody Likes Mail, especially at camp! When sending letters to your camper, make sure to focus on the fun and interesting things that are happening at camp, rather than reminders or news from home. That will help a lot with homesickness! Bring mail with you at drop-off, the first day of camp. Drop mail off at the Kiosk only.
- Label each piece of mail with the Camper's Name, cabin number, and what day you would like them to get it. We do NOT do mail on the last day of camp.
- Please do NOT mail letters via the USPS, rarely will it arrive on time.
- Camper mail should be notes and letters from home, or small items like a stuffed animal or glow sticks. We discourage dropping off large boxes filled with food/candy. Sending money for the Camp Store & Cafe is a better alternative if you want to gift them with a treat.

Account Balances

- All camp fees must be paid by 5:00pm the Wednesday before camp starts. If you need to cancel camp for any reason please do so as soon as possible (the \$75 is non-refundable at any time). If camp is canceled after 5:00pm the Wednesday prior to the camp starting, the entire camp fee will be due. If camp is canceled before 5:00pm the Wednesday prior to the camp starting, any money paid over the \$75 deposit, can be refunded to you. The \$75 deposit is non-refundable and non-transferrable no matter when the cancellation occurs.
